

Coronavirus: How are employers responding? Report 3

We carried out our third benchmarking survey between 1 and 3 April with 67 senior HR and legal counsel as the situation with Coronavirus rapidly evolved.



7 out of 10 employers who are furloughing staff are topping up the government grant (which covers 80% of an employee's regular wages, up to a cap of £2,500 per month)



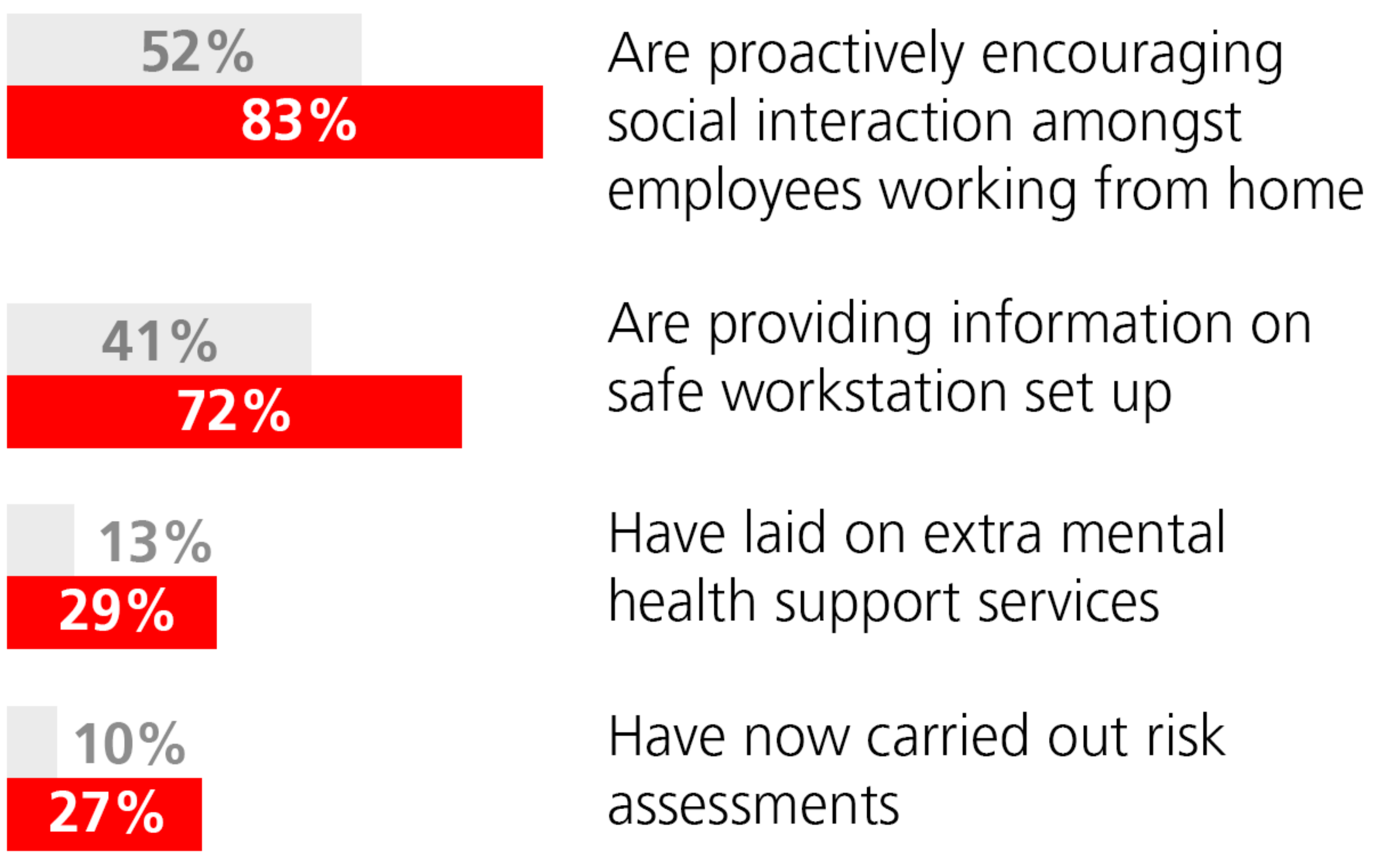
An overwhelming **80%** of employers would be willing to let furloughed employees work elsewhere with their permission (e.g. in essential services, health and social care or supermarkets)

9% of employers have already given their furloughed staff some training to do

20% are expecting to ask furloughed staff to complete training whilst furloughed

45% have not thought about this yet, suggesting that training will be the next item on the agenda once employers have resolved the immediate practical arrangements
